Overview's

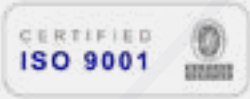

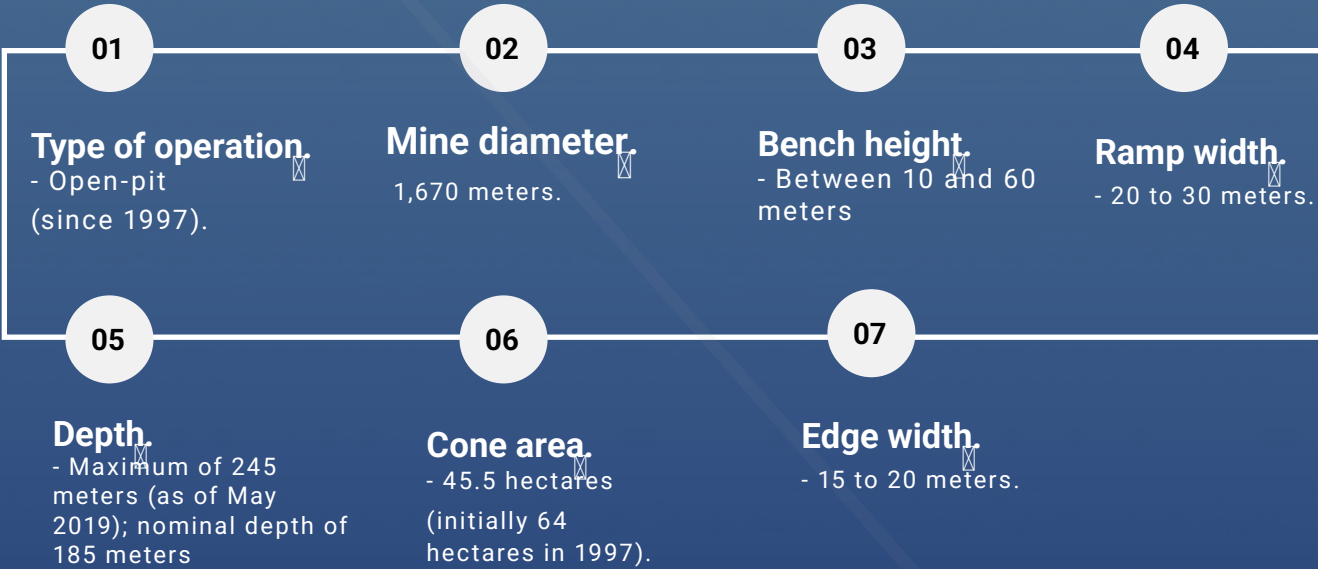

Largest Open-Pit Diamond Mine**

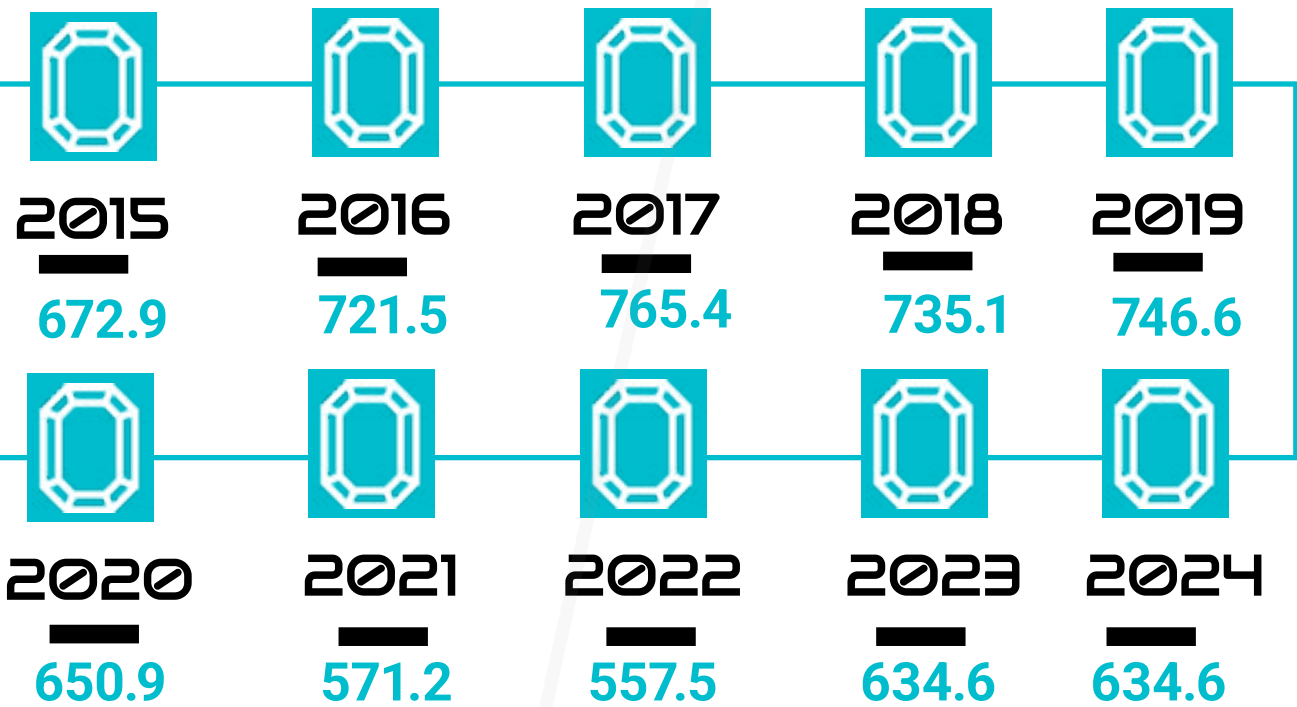
Technical Data of the Mine //

Mining is the foundation of Catoca Mining Company's operations, representing the strategic pillar that supports all of its activities in the diamond sector. Since the beginning of operations on February 11, 1997, with the installation of the first treatment plant, the company has expanded its capacity and solidified its position as a global leader in the industry.

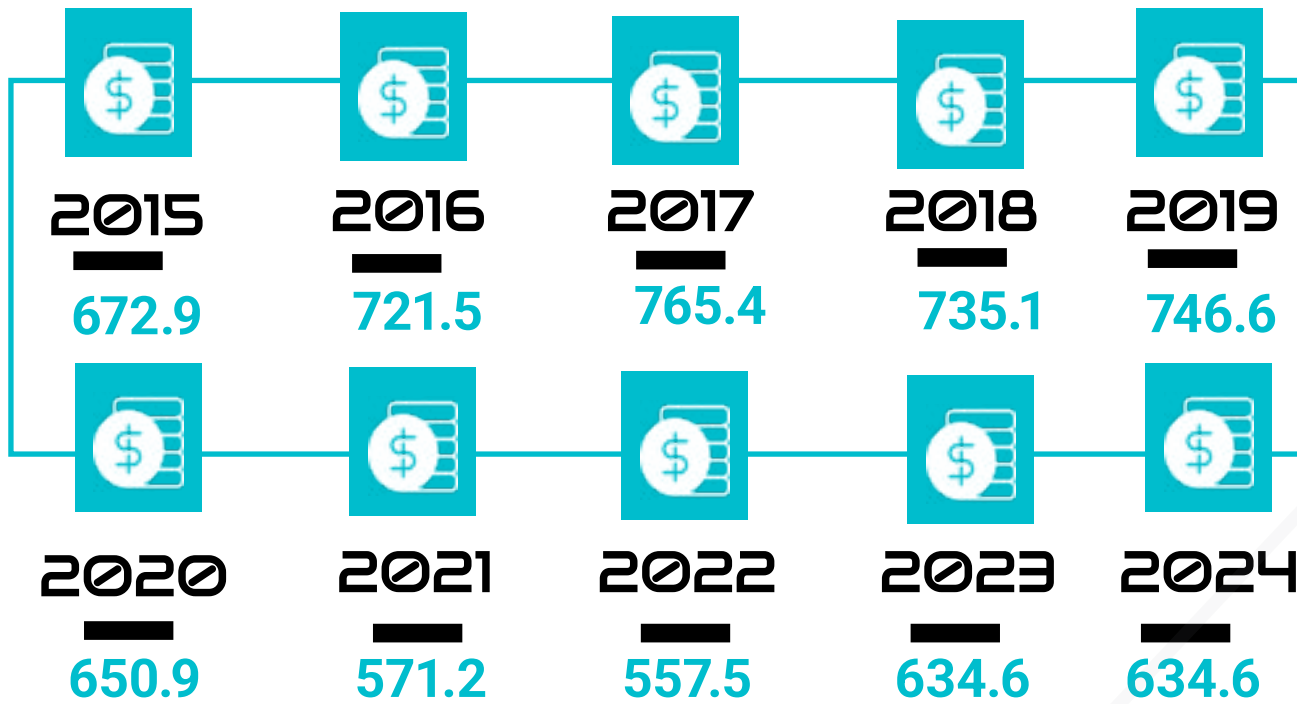
Catoca operates on a large scale, extracting an average of 10 million tons of ore annually and handling approximately 18 million cubic meters of material annually, including 11 million cubic meters of barren rock.

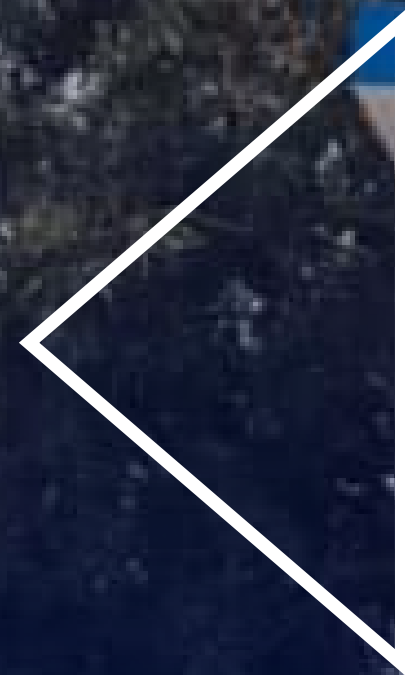

Housing

Access to decent housing is one of the main shortcomings in the communities surrounding Catoca. In order to alleviate this shortage, Catoca implemented the neighbourhood resettlement project, which aims to develop decent spaces for people to live and thrive, with the necessary housing conditions.

+2.3 M USD invested in social housing annually in the construction of more than **150 homes** for the community surrounding the Catoca mine, with a total of **+1,800 families** covered.

Sociedade Mineira de Catoca believes that providing access to healthcare in disadvantaged communities is not only an act of saving lives, but also an opportunity to empower them and help break the cycle of poverty in search of a healthier, more dignified, and prosperous future.

With an investment of more than **2.5 million USD** a year, Catoca builds an average of +5 medical posts a year, where more than **+24,300 users** are assisted, in a universe of more than **+11,800 medical consultations** carried out, in 42 communities.
